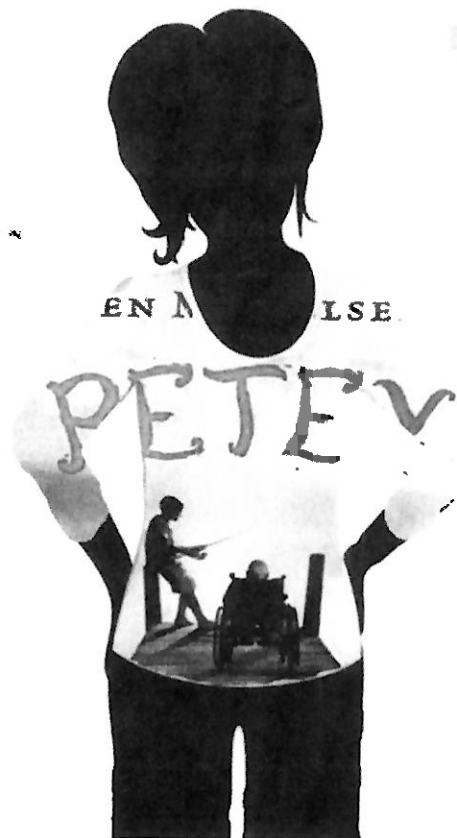
Spring Sports
